

Adoption Procedure

- 1. WHEREAS we believe that children are neither the property nor the chattels of their parents, nor the chattels of the state, nor of any religious group, but rather persons in their own right, deserving the fullest protection of society and its laws:
- 2. THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Canadian Unitarian Council goes on record as being in opposition to our present adoptive practices and/or legislation which segregates children according to the presumed religion of one or more of their natural parents and thus deprive some children of the advantages of adoption in the name of religion.
