The CUC's Resolutions Process is designed to include all types of resolutions within one process. This flowchart provides a quick look at the process and timelines. For details such as who is eligible to propose a resolution and what to include in the Action Plan, please refer to the Resolutions Process document.

Each resolution, accompanied by an Action Plan, must be submitted to the Executive Director by **December 15** prior to the Annual General Meeting at which it will be considered. 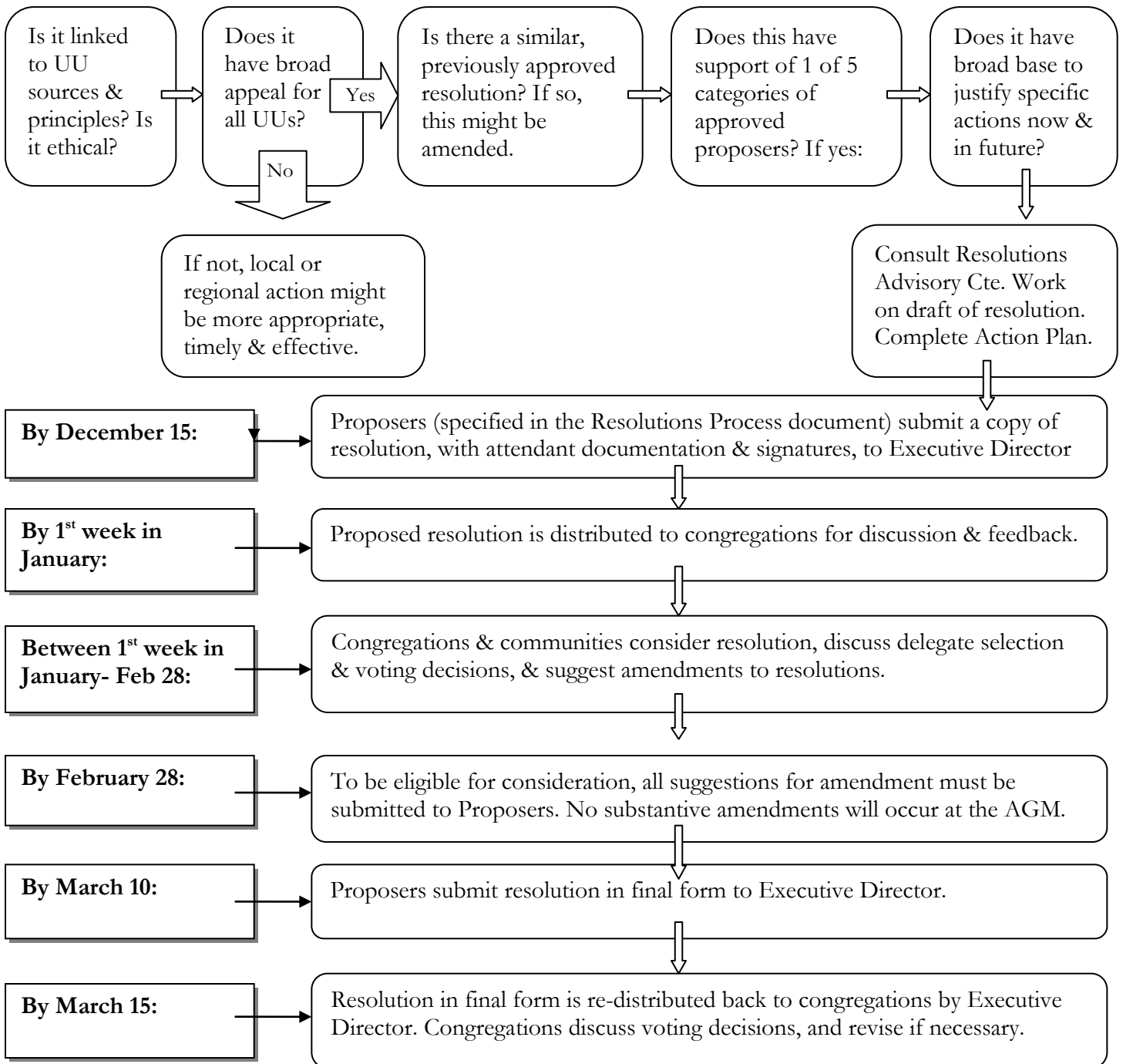

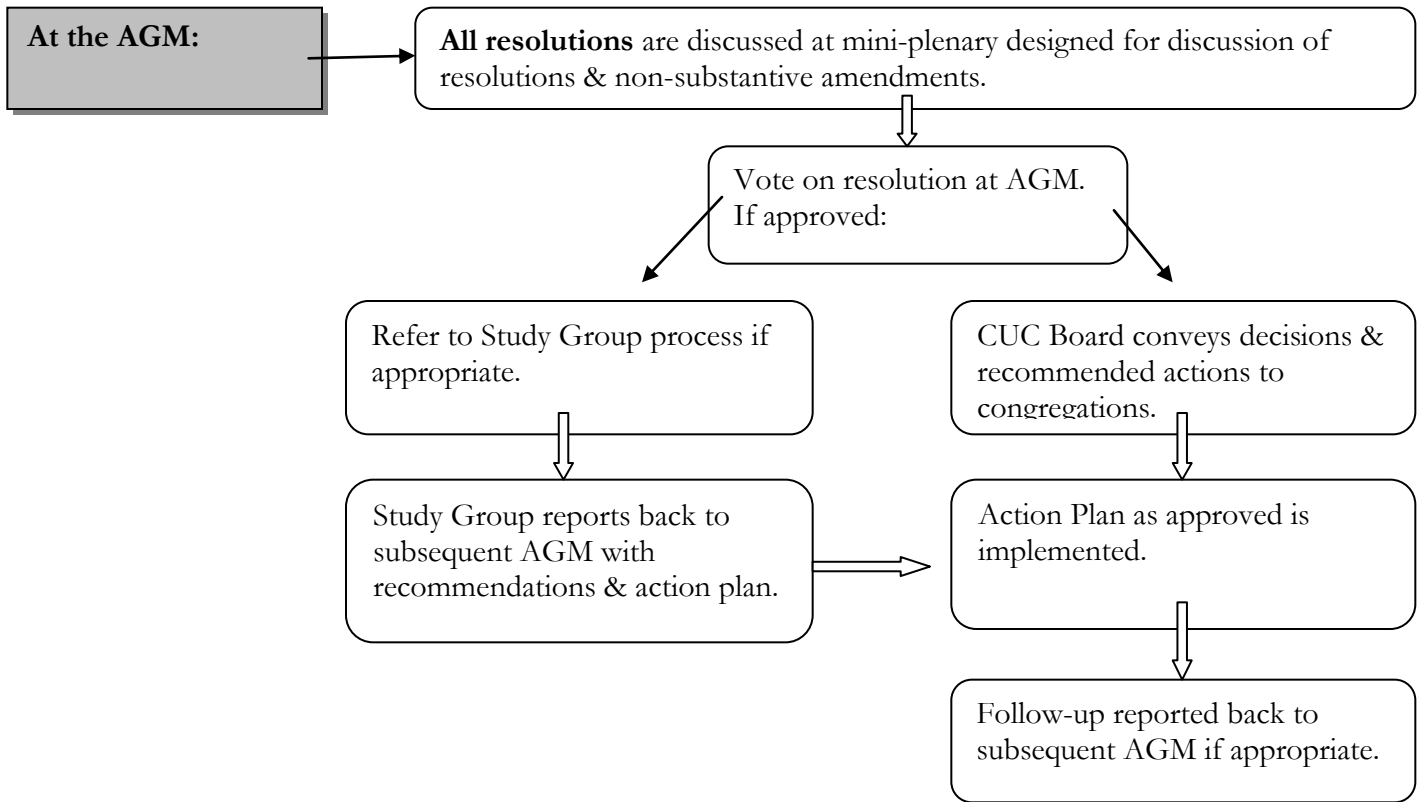
