## Unitarian Universalist United Nations Office (UU-UNO) - Intergenerational Spring Seminar Information Handout for Canadian UU Youth & Youth Advisors

### What is the UU-UNO Spring Seminar?

Every April, youth and adults from around the United States, Canada and beyond gather in New York City for an exciting and educational Intergenerational Spring Seminar.

UUs attend the Spring Seminar to:

- Gain a deep understanding on topics of global concern
- Listen to insightful speakers from around the world
- Learn, make friends, have fun, and even sleep!
- Take on important leadership roles in planning and execution
- Find out how to become global activists

All participants learn about a topic of global concern in a fun intergenerational environment. Past seminars have focused on poverty, HIV, human trafficking, peacekeeping, climate change, and empowerment of women. Youth and youth advisors stay at one of the Manhattan-based hostels while learning, connecting with others, organizing and mobilizing. Not only do youth attend the conference, but many also hold important leadership roles in its planning and execution.

### Why Youth Should Go

The spring seminar is an opportunity for youth to learn about an issue of global importance in a professional learning environment and with the guidance and wisdom of international experts. Youth form friendships with youth from around North America, and may get to visit the United Nations plaza. Creative activities are integrated with the learning experience.

### Topic 2019: Equity in Action - Gender in an Intersecting World

Sessions include understanding the reality of the non-binary nature of gender, the conditioned performance of gender within cultural context, the #MeToo movement which calls to the world to believe and support survivors of sexual violence, confronting internal biases, and working for gender at the intersection of dismantling systems of oppression.

Registration includes programming and some meals - it does NOT cover housing for participants 18+. Youth are all housed in Hostelling International NYC.

<b>Gas share</b> (Ottawa–Syracuse return)	\$25	3 vehicles ~4 people per vehicle
<b>Train</b> Syracuse–NYC return	~\$122.00	<b>Possible discounts</b> 10% AAA (likely CAA) 20% (group rate) 20% (in-state) Subsidy money (see below) can cover ticket purchases. Usually coordinator purchases all tickets

<b>Hostel (3 nights)</b>	~\$150	
<b>Spending &amp; subway money (estimate)</b>	\$100	Subway fares fare about \$2.75 one-way. The hostel is about 35-40 mins by subway from the UU-UNO building.
<b>Gross Cost</b>	~\$872 (Youth) ~\$847 (Young Adult) ~\$700 (Adult)

- Registration, travel and accommodations should be coordinated by a youth advisor
